#### **Requirements For Applicants**

- A. Parent/ legal guardian must be a member of the Central Valley Education Association. Student must be a high school senior graduating in the 2021-2022 school year.
- B. Enroll as a full-time student at an accredited university, community college or trade school for the 2022-2023 school year.
- C. Have a cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher (7 semesters).
- D. Include documentation of your 2022 FAFSA score with the application. *Some consideration* of the scholarship is based on need.
- E. Be an active participant in civic affairs of school, church and/or community.
- F. Send a copy of his/her official high school transcript (through 7 semesters) with the application.
- G. Request two (2) letters of reference from anyone other than a relative. The letters should be confidential and in a sealed envelope.
- H. The applicant needs to write a personal statement (250 words or less) indicating the career of their choice.
- I. Return application, transcript, documented FAFSA score, personal statement and letters of reference to:

- A. Drop off your applications at the CVEA office between 8:00 am and 3:00 pm.
- B. Send through district courier to the CVEA office.
- C. Send to the above address through US postal service.
- \*\*Once the scholarship application is received, you will be sent a confimation email indicating receipt, if complete, and or if additional information is needed. If you do not receive a confirmation, we do not have the application.

Completed application packet (all required materials) must be received at the CVEA office no later than <u>Friday, April 22, 2022.</u> Applications received after that date will not be considered. Consider allowing extra time if sending through the courier or US postal service.

- > Each scholarship grant will be for one year only
